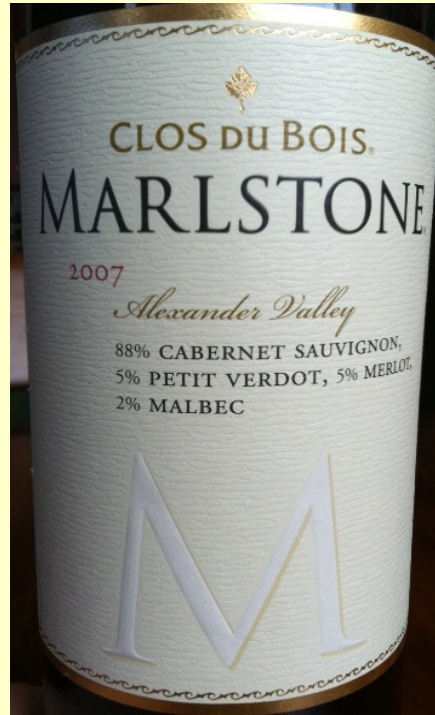


# 2007 Clos du Bois “Marlstone” (Cabernet-Merlot)

Yet another California spin on the Old World tradition, this breathtaking favorite from Clos du Bois began in 1978 as one of Sonoma's very first Bordeaux-style blends. It was made from fruit grown exclusively in the Marlstone Vineyard in Alexander Valley, an area known for rich, fleshy wines with a bit spicier expression.

Clos du Bois has also long been committed to sustainable practices with over 4,000 solar panels and water conscious practices in place for many years, they have received many awards, recognitions & certifications since 2001 for doing their part.

**The wine exhibits a complex aroma of blackberry, cedar and nutmeg, which is followed by a mouthful of concentrated fruit and fine grained tannins. Overall, it was built for maximum expression: powerful and balanced while finishing long and rich.**
