

Marsuret “Saia” Prosecco, Extra Dry Spumante

We all know that Prosecco is a hot value but glamour often delivers superficiality. Not so with the Marsura family's wines. They have a long tradition in wine growing and, as with the vines they tend, their wines are a genuine product of the Valdobbiadene hills since purchasing the vineyards in 1936.

Although they offer a finer selection of pricey single-vineyard Proseccos of truly unique identity, the “Saia” line over-delivers on that distinctive Prosecco character.

This semi-sparkling and not quite Brut sparkler shows an apple scent with a lighter note of fresh-cut flowers. Its vivacious fizz is more delicate than a Champenoise Method wine but is in perfect harmony with its lighter structure.
