

2012 Belle Glos "Meiomi" Pinot Noir

Santa Barbara– Monterey– Sonoma, California



Bucking tradition, "Meiomi" is a blend of fruit from three separate wine regions stretching along the California coast: Sonoma, Monterey and, last but not least, Santa Barbara. This is blended from a series of vineyards selected by Joe Wagner, the winemaker for Belle Glos and the grandson of the founder of Caymus Vineyards. Each batch is chosen for its unique flavors, textures and aromas.

These three growing regions brilliantly meld together in this deeply flavored, stylish and truly balanced Pinot Noir; at its most fundamental core, it is an approachable, food friendly wine with a style and place all its own.
