

2012 Château Valcombe “Epicure” Rosé

Ventoux, Rhône Valley, France



Whether or not you already consider yourself a fan of high quality Rosé, this is one extraordinarily delicious wine worth a try!

Made from a classic pair of grapes in the Syrah/Shiraz family named Grenache and Cinsault from vines averaging 40 years-old, this wine proves what a great vintage 2012 was for rosé in southeastern France.

Wines made from Grenache and Cinsault are typically light to medium-bodied with perfumed aromas from the Cinsault, and with Grenache adding spicy, raspberry flavors and a more rounded texture.

Recommended pairings: Baked Goat Cheese appetizer served with roasted garlic and olive oil and our house-made flat bread

Mixed greens Salad with Herb-encrusted Goat Cheese, caramelized apple and sun-dried cranberries, tossed with a honey balsamic dressing
